### Frequently Asked Questions

How long is the Phoebe House Program? 6-8 months depending on individual progress

### Can I leave Phoebe House whilst completing program?

Residents may leave Phoebe House for weekend leave and community engagement in the higher stages of the program.

### What is community engagement?

We want to encourage mothers at Phoebe House to navigate their way into the community safely with their children. Community engagement involves scheduled outings to safe environments (e.g. swimming lessons, appointments, self care activities etc.)

## How often do I have counselling and case management?

Residents attend weekly individual counselling sessions and case management sessions.

### Can I use my phone at Phoebe House?

Yes, residents at Phoebe House are able to use their phones. It is a requirement to use mobile phones respectfully during the program.

### Can I see my partner at Phoebe House?

Partners are not permitted to step foot into our service, residents are able to see family and friends during their weekend leave.

#### Can I smoke at Phoebe House?

Phoebe House is a smoke free environment, we currently have limited smoking hours in a designated area.

- Be on an opioid treatment program
- Be pregnant or have a child aged 0-5 years (in care or access minimum once per fortnight).
- Be willing to make change for healthy recovery
